
Introduction

CHDMI-8 is a high performance HDMI distribution amplifier. It allows one HDMI source to connect up to 8 HDMI displays simultaneously.

Features


- 1. Built-in EDID simulator and HDCP keyset allows each output to work independently when connecting to a HDMI display.
- 2. Splits a HDMI source up to 8 outputs without signal loss.
- 3. Supports DVI source and DVI display by using HDMI to/from DVI adaptor cable.
- 4. Supports a wide range of PC and HDTV resolutions-from VGA to UXGA and 480p to 1080p. Maximum resolution bandwidth-165MHz.
- 5. Can be cascaded up to 3 layers, or more if using high quality cable.
- 6. Each of the buffered output can run up to 15 meters@1600x1200.

Operation Controls and Functions Front Panel



- 1. HDMI output 1/2/3: Connects to the HDMI input of your displays.
- 2. HDMI input: Connects to the HDMI or DVI output of your source equipment such as DVD player or Set-Top-Box.
- 3. Sync LED: The LED will illuminate when the HDMI source signal is connected to the input and is detected by the unit.
- 4. Power input: Plug the supplied 5VDC power supply into the unit. The LED will illuminate when connected.

Rear Panel



1. HDMI output 4/5/6/7/8: Connects each of these output ports to the HDMI input of a HDMI display.
